Our Lenten Journey

We will begin our forty-day Lenten journey to the glories of Easter this Wednesday, February 17. The symbol of ashes that we receive on Ash Wednesday are a reminder to us of our mortality and the call to repent, to turn away from sin and believe the Good News.

Note: This year because of the coronavirus, instead of receiving the ashes on our forehead a small amount of ashes will be sprinkled on our head. Lent is a time for us to take stock of ourselves, a time to make a personal inventory of how we are responding to the call of the Lord to live a life of holiness as children of God led by the gift of the Holy Spirit. The forty days of Lent can be a time of great personal and spiritual growth if we take the time to work on our relationships with God and with one another. To assist you in your daily prayer during Lent devotional booklets are available at our churches. **The Little Black Book**, **The Magnificat Lenten Companion** as well as **The Word Among Us** are all available in the churches as well as at the church office.

Operation Rice Bowl is once again our parish Lenten alms giving program. This Catholic Relief Services Lenten program helps people in developing countries to break the cycle of poverty by developing skills and means to provide for their families. Experience how families around the world live, work and play in a series of short **Stories of Hope** at www.crsricebowl.org. CRS Rice Bowl is Catholic Relief Services' Lenten faith-in-action program. It offers opportunities for your family to engage daily with the spiritual pillars of Lent: prayer, fasting and almsgiving. And it's an opportunity for our parish to come together as a community and practice the works of mercy with our neighbors and our brothers and sisters around the world. During the 40 days of Lent, we will encounter the stories of communities in Madagascar, El Salvador and Timor-Leste where CRS is at work. We'll be invited to eat simple, meatless meals from these countries. Through the stories, we'll learn about the principles of Catholic social teaching—and ways we can put them into action during Lent and beyond. We will reflect on how we are called to recognize the suffering Christ in the most vulnerable members of our global human family. We will see how our prayers, fasting and almsgiving can provide for those worldwide who are most in need, especially those who are hungry and lack proper nutrition. I'm excited to take this journey with our parish community, and to connect the prayer and reflections of each of our families to our global community of faith. I hope you will take home a CRS Rice Bowl, located in the church vestibules and at the parish office.
