Faith Formation

The mission of the Faith Formation program here at GSCC, is to foster an environment where students learn that faith is a lifetime journey through sacraments, education and spiritual development. As a faith formation team, we seek to provide knowledge, unity, love and the peace of Christ as proclaimed in the Gospels and to live as disciples of Jesus in our world today.

This coming school year our theme is a Year of Mercy as proclaimed by our Holy Father, Pope Francis. As Jesus tells His disciples “ Be merciful as your Father is merciful” (Luke 6:36) . During this year of mercy and forgiveness, we will celebrate two Sacraments: **First Penance or Reconciliation & First Holy Communion. We will also begin** preparing our students for the **Sacrament of Confirmation**. Listed below are the dates and times of meetings & classes. Please mark your calendars accordingly.

Faith Formation classes begin **on Sunday, September 20**. We will also celebrate **Catechetical Sunday** on that day. It is a special occasion where we bless the Catechists during the Mass for their ministry. There will be a **Faith Formation Teacher’s Meeting on Sunday, September 13 at 11:30am at the Parish House in King Ferry**.

The Sacrament of First Penance or Reconciliation will be held on Saturday, October 24 at 10:30am at St Patrick’s, Moravia and 1:00pm at Our Lady of the Lake, King Ferry. First Holy Communion will be held in the Spring of 2016.

Confirmation- The Sacrament of Confirmation is now a two year program. A Parent/Student Confirmation Meeting will be held on Thursday, September 10 at 7:00pm at St Patrick’s, Aurora. If your child is interesting in enrolling in our Confirmation program- please plan on attending this meeting. All of us in The Diocese of Rochester are following the same format, covering the same topics and using approved curriculum. GSCC will offer students three options: Classes held weekly at St. Patrick’s, Moravia and led by Steve Cardinal. Confirmation classes at Our Lady of the Lake will meet bimonthly with Mariann Fessenden and Elisa Van Amburgh on a Friday or Saturday evening. (The schedule will be distributed). Lastly, parents also have the option of home schooling their child. There will be Confirmation Review Sessions held every 6 weeks at St Patrick’s, Aurora. We will be covering 17 topics during Year 1. Some topics include: Church History, The Gospels, Mary, The Liturgical Year, Catholic Social Teachings, Prayer, and Moral Decision Making. Along with classes, Confirmands will be required to engage in service oppotunities and attend a one day retreat. The Confirmation team consists of: Steve Cardinal, Mariann Fessenden, Monica Groth, Therese Shook, Elisa Van Amburgh, Father Bill, and myself. This team is committed to guiding the path of our Confirmands on a meaningful experience as they take a significant step in their faith.

As we begin a new school year together, I am excited to journey along with all of our students as they grow and flourish in their faith. Marilyn
