Vacation Bible School 2016

" Surf Shack: Catch the Wave of God's Amazing Love"

Once again this summer we are off on an adventure at Vacation Bible School, August 1,2, 3 &4 on the lake at St Patrick's, Aurora. To preregister, please fill out the VBS forms that are available at each of the churches and return them to us by placing them in the collection basket or sending them in the mail. Vacation Bible School begins each day at 9:30am with praise songs on the lawn. Then each group of VBS students travel with their Group Leader to the various stations which include Bible, Craft and Game Centers. We gather together again at 11:30am for a snack and fellowship and close our day with praise songs. This year the theme is "Surf Shack: Catch The Wave of God's Amazing Love". Students will begin the first day of our week together with the Creation story. The Bible begins with words: In the beginning God created... Our students will learn about the wonder and blessing of all that God has created. Day 2 the message continues in the Old Testament with the Book of Exodus. Miriam cares for baby Moses on the Nile River. The students will hear how God's abundant love surrounded Moses and his life circumstances. Day 3 we will talk about the Baptism of Jesus as it appears in Gospel of Matthew. "This is my Son whom I dearly love, I find happiness in him." And lastly on Day 4 the message is Jesus calming the storm as written in Luke's Gospel. The students will learn that our deep faith and God's love will help us to weather the storms in our lives. On our last day together we will celebrate with an Ice Cream Social and a special closing ceremony. At VBS our students will experience how God Creates, God Helps, God Loves and God Calms. Join us as we catch the waves each day at Vacation Bible School of God's amazing love.

Jubilee of Mercy Pilgrimage:

"A pilgrimage is a journey or search of moral or spiritual significance. Typically, it is a journey to a shrine or other location of importance to a person's beliefs and faith".

Deacon Dennis is willing to lead a weekend pilgrimage to the Divine Mercy Shrine in Stockbridge MA. Looking at early September and would stop along the way at the Shrines of St. Kateri and The North American Martyrs as well as pass through the Holy Doors of the Cathedral in Albany. We would attend Mass each day at one of these locations.

There will be two options: A bus and hotel option for under \$200 for a single room and significantly less for a double. Or an independent travel option where you drive on your own vehicle and follow all or part of the itinerary covering your own travel cost and paying a small stipend for our donations to the Shrines.
