Notes from Father Bill:

I arrived at Good Shepherd Catholic Community on June 24th, 2014; so I have now been here for a little over a year. Our parish ending its fiscal year 2014-2015 on June 30 and I am happy to report that we finished it in a good position. We closed the year with a net revenue of \$16,844 in spite of the fact that we had some unbudgeted expenses, among them was replacing a boiler at St. Patrick Church in Aurora.

Last year I acknowledged that many of you increased your Sunday Collection offering during the past year and I thanked you for your generous response. And I mentioned then that as we go forward we will need to have a strong Sunday offering to meet the ongoing parish expenses and to address the maintenance issues. Well I am happy to report that our regular collections, (that is our Sunday, Holy days, Christmas, Easter and Fuel collections) once again increased! The Sunday collections were up by nearly \$17,000 and the total regular collections were up by over \$22,000. I once again thank you for your generous support. With your continuing strong financial support we can budget for and address more of the maintenance needs in our parish as well as assisting us to meet the pastoral needs of our parishioners and outreach to our brothers and sisters, especially those in need. As you decide the amount that you regularly contribute to the parish I ask all of you to think in terms of a tithing mentality, offering your "first fruits" back to the Lord. The biblical notion of tithing was to offer the first ten percent of what you produced to the Lord. I have personally tithed in that way for most of my adult life. What I ask of you is to consider prayerfully giving a percentage of your income to the Lord. Whatever you decide to give, make a commitment to give first to the Lord. You will be blessed for your generosity.

The Vacation Bible School 2015 is coming up soon, August 3,4,5 and 6! This year's theme is "Shining Star- Where Kids Shine God's Light". I hope that your children can attend. I have always enjoyed VBS week. In my years in Tioga County it was a highlight of the Summer! The enthusiasm and energy of the children I find strengthen the faith of all the adults involved and me as well! The VBS is held at St. Patrick Church, Aurora and begins each day with praise and song each day at 9:30a.m. So come and enjoy the week by the lake. Remember it was at the lakeside that Jesus so often taught his disciples.
